Year 8 and 9 Students
Oasis Academy: Enfield Sports Day

Our annual Sports Day will be taking place on **Tuesday 13th July** at the Lee Valley Athletics Centre, Pickett’s Lock. Throughout the day students will take part in a variety of traditional athletics events along with a Learning Family Tug of War Competition. The event will run from 10am until 3:30pm.

This year we are asking Year 8 and 9 students to make their own way down to the track on Sports Day. They will need to arrive at the track in Pickett’s Lock between 09:30am-10:15am so that they can be registered and prepare for their morning events. The first events will start at 10:30am prompt, so it is essential that they arrive to the venue on time. The W8 bus service is one form of public transport that they may wish to take if you are unable to drop them off/collect them at the specified time (Chase Farm, Gordon Hill Station, Silver Street, Great Cambridge Road – Church Street, Edmonton Green Station, Pickett’s Lock Centre).

All students are asked to arrive at the track in their correct PE kit (polo shirt, shorts, socks and trainers). I would also advise them to bring their Academy Tracksuit if they have one in case the weather is cold. *It is vital that students do come in their kit as their will not be time or space for them to change at the track.* Please ensure that your son/daughter leaves all valuables at home on the day of the event.

Students will be required to bring a packed lunch from home as there are no food outlets at the track. All students must bring a refillable bottle of water to ensure that they remain fully hydrated throughout the day.

Spectators are very welcome at Lee Valley Athletics Track, but we must request that you stay in the specified parent area on the grass verge away from the stand. Please note there are no seats in this area so be prepared to sit on the grass. Entry will be by ticket only. Should you wish to come and watch your son/daughter compete in their events then tickets can be obtained from the Academy Reception from Thursday 8th July. Please note that you **will not** be allowed to take any photographs on the day due to child protection guidelines.

WEATHER WARNING: Being Britain the weather could do absolutely anything, so please have your child prepared for any eventuality. They may need sun cream, a hat and most definitely plenty of water. If the weather is not in our favour then they may need to bring their school tracksuit and a waterproof jacket.
