

The ARC: Inclusive Curriculum

The ARC is the **Academy Resources Centre** for interventions at Oasis Academy Enfield.

It is the place at OAE that provides long and short-term systematic and graduated approaches using interventions that support our students' needs with internal and external solutions.

The ARC is a multi-faceted centre that promotes transformational inclusivity at the heart of its curriculum. This establishes a culture for every student to develop both personally and academically in a safe environment which nurtures the confidence in each student to build on the characteristics of the 9 Habits through Personal Development and the Enfield Way (#LEARN).

Our curriculum is inclusive of and allows access to taught subjects, group work, interventions, 121 sessions and collaborative work with organisations in and outside of the Borough of Enfield.

Our intent is to dedicate our professionalism to meeting the needs of our students by continuing to create bespoke learning experiences and pathways that enable our students to succeed. This will enable students to make informed decisions about their continued educational experiences and beyond.

Character: We want our students to develop behaviours and skills that enable them to be the best they can be. Students will be equipped to LEARN by being given opportunities to lead and excel in any of the areas of our inclusive curriculum. This ranges from core subjects to art and PE; from group work to 121; from personal development to GCSE's. Students will aspire to be the best that they can be through our element to nurture and gain an understanding of how the 9 Habits promote positive and crucial characteristics for life.

Competence: Students will break barriers to develop crucial soft skills and learning by facing the challenges that can hinder them from progress. Being able to do all of this in a safe place will support students when mistakes are made, to master techniques, skills and understanding that build resilience. Students will be empowered to engage in conversations around Personal Development and will also experience the importance of understanding society by **LEARN**ing the #EnfieldWay. A range of literature and reading also encompasses this.

Community: Students will learn to understand their identity and place within the school community and beyond. We facilitate this with the vision to help students to be the best they can be leading to fulfilled, and purposeful lives both now and for the future. The wide variety of services that are offered by NEXUS, Enfield Council, The Rudolph Walker Foundation and more, afford us the opportunity to engage our students with the wider community both within and outside of school.

How students LEARN with the ARC curriculum at OAE:

The ARC Inclusive curriculum is designed to give all students opportunities to develop within the Enfield Way (#LEARN), as well-rounded leaders who aspire to excel and succeed through resilience and good character, with the ability to map out a positive future. This is done through a 7-strand multi-layered approach, which enables the unique aspect of formulating bespoke educational pathways that meet the needs of each student. Our resources include teachers, inclusion staff and community input through Enfield Nexus, Enfield Support Services, and other organisations.

We aim to achieve more positive school experiences for our students to embrace; giving them a sense of well-being and confidence to achieve.
