Year 11	<p><b>Sources of finance and business accounting</b></p> <p>Explore the different options to a business for funding and evaluate the advantages and disadvantages of each option for a given business scenario. Develop business mathematical skills using essential technical equations and calculations.</p> <p><b><u>Written Assessment:</u></b> Assessment of key business mathematical concepts using a scenario</p> <p>AO1, AO2, AO3, AO4</p>	<p><b>Unit 1 revision</b></p> <p>To prepare for the Unit 1 resit in November, students will be recapping the more challenging concepts whilst simultaneously practicing key exam skills and how to answer 9 mark questions.</p> <p><b><u>Written assessment:</u></b> Mock exam</p> <p>AO1, AO2, AO3</p>	<p><b>Business and enterprise planning</b></p> <p>Understand the components of a business plan, the importance and the practical uses. Students will be given examples of business plans for a variety of businesses and will dissect the sections to explore what makes a <i>good</i> business plan.</p> <p><b><u>Written assessment:</u></b> Practice assessment whereby students create their own business plan based on a stimulus.</p> <p>AO1, AO5</p>	<p><b>Unit 2 assessment</b></p> <p>Students spend 21 hours in a computer room completing their unit 2 synoptic assessment. Moderation across OAH and OAE.</p> <p><b><u>Written assessment:</u></b> Students complete their Unit 2 assessment</p> <p>AO1, AO2, AO3, AO4, AO5</p>	<p><b>Feedback and resubmission</b></p> <p>Teacher to provide feedback on internal synoptic assessment and explain how students can implement their feedback. Students entitled to another 21 hours to implement feedback and resubmit assessment. Moderation across OAH and OAE.</p> <p><b><u>Written assessment:</u></b> Students complete resubmission based on individual teacher feedback.</p> <p>AO1, AO2, AO3, AO4, AO5</p>
