

## ABC Links to literacy

In MFL we develop literacy through listening, reading, speaking and writing tasks. You also develop your use of different grammatical structures and complex language.

### AUTUMN - 2

Topic name: **Free time**  
Why study this topic?

This topic of Free Time builds on the foundations of grammatical knowledge started in the first unit, such as recognising and applying key infinitives, talking in the first and third person, and using adjectives, connectives and negatives.

### SPRING - 2

Topic name: **School**  
Why study this topic?

This unit builds on the language you have gained in your first three units. You will revisit verb conjugation and expressing opinions. You will start to build complex sentences by including time and comparatives.

### SUMMER - 2

Topic name: **Film**  
Why study this topic?

This film studies topic builds on the foundations of grammatical knowledge you have gained in their first year, such as recognising and applying key infinitives, using tenses, talking in the first and third person, and using adjectives, connectives and negatives. In this unit, you will use the film as a real stimulus for discussion.

## Subject Intent statement

Our MFL curriculum is knowledge-rich, focusing on remembering and mastering key vocabulary and grammatical structures. You will be able to thrive in other countries by having spontaneous conversations in different languages and be aware of different cultures

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### AUTUMN - 1

Topic name: **In class**  
Why study this topic?

In this topic you will learn key classroom language that will enable you to communicate in the classroom in the target language.

### SPRING - 1

Topic name: **Family**  
Why study this topic?

This topic of family builds on your language knowledge from previous topics. You will learn key vocabulary on this topic. You will also be able to describe people using the third person and adjectives.

### SUMMER - 1

Topic name: **Holidays**  
Why study this topic?

The 'my holidays' unit introduces to key travel and tourism vocabulary which will build into the GCSE theme 2 later on. You will consolidate verb conjugation and are introduced to the perfect tense.
