Dear parent/carer,

As you aware, the Academy has a strict policy that mobile phones, head/earphones and airpods are prohibited in the Academy. If these items are seen or heard, they will be confiscated and can only be collected from reception by parents or carer.

This policy has helped to significantly reduce the incidents of phones being lost or stolen, and sending/sharing of inappropriate messages/images that potentially cause arguments and disruption to the school day.

With this in mind, can I encourage you to spend some time talking to your child about the appropriate use of mobile phones and other devices when sending and sharing messages. It is important that students realise that they have a responsibility to use their phones and devices in an appropriate way, which they are reminded of through PSHE lessons and assemblies. We have also invited our Safer Schools Police Officer in to talk to students about the risks, dangers and consequences of sending/receiving inappropriate messages/images.
